Application Guidelines

Applications are to be made via the online application form at bankorange.com.au

Only applications submitted during the application opening times and before the deadline will be accepted for assessment.



The following groups are eligible to apply:

- Incorporated not-for-profit organisations, community groups or registered charities
- Commercial entities may be considered, however they must demonstrate significant benefit to the community.

Note: A charitable organisation must be registered with the Australian Charities and Not-For-Profit Commission to raise funds in the community. Money from the organisation must go back into the community not the charity for activities or administration purposes.



Bank Orange will not consider sponsorship or donations of any group/organisation or business that:

- May be construed as discriminatory.
- Could be detrimental to public health or safety.
- Promote or encourage substance abuse.
- Individuals seeking support for overseas travel or academic study.
- Religious or political organisations or campaigns.
- Programs that may present a hazard to the community or the environment.
- Programs that contribute to the financial gain of an individual or business.
- Activities that are the direct responsibility of the Government.
- Non-specific fundraising projects or appeals.
- Could be misinterpreted as a bribe or kickback.

Programs that best align to the vision and mission of Bank Orange are encouraged. If an organisation demonstrates the values of Bank Orange as Collaboration, Excellence, Sustainability, Authenticity and/or Development, their application will be highly regarded.

Applications will be accepted from across the Central West and regional NSW who meet the eligibility criteria and can demonstrate their commitment to building their local community.
